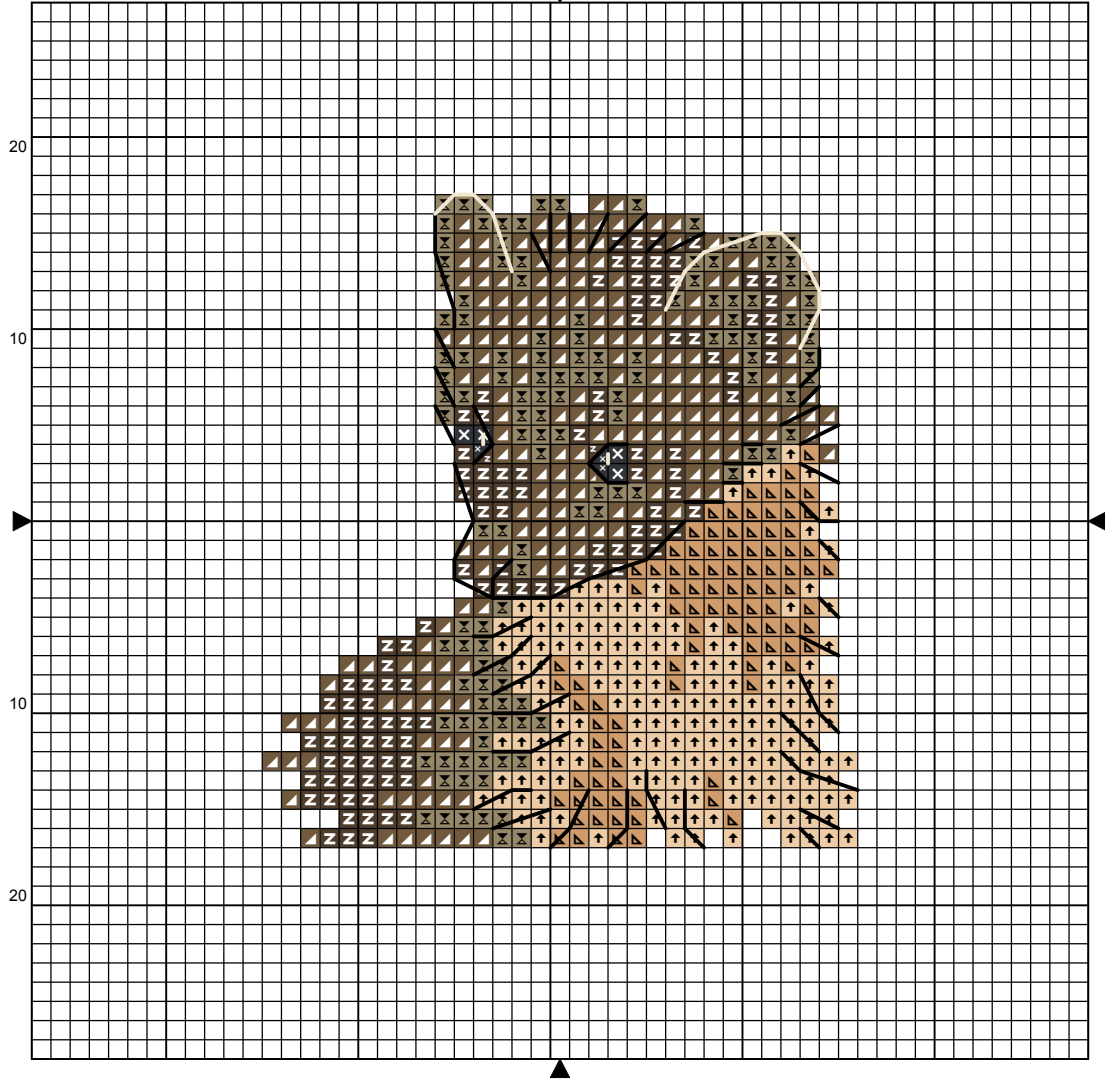

**Design size:** 2.21 x 2.43 inches or 5.62 x 6.17 cm









## Instructions and Symbol Key for Design "BftB Pine Marten"

**Fabric:** 14 count White Aida

**Stitches:** 31 x 34      **Size:** 2.21 x 2.43 inches or 5.62 x 6.17 cm

**Colours:** DMC

Use 2 strands of thread for cross stitch

Use 1 strand of thread for backstitch

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### Back from the Brink

A set of seven endangered British Wildlife designs created in partnership with Back from the Brink, an ambitious conservation project focussed on bringing some of Britain's most threatened species of animals, plants and fungi back from extinction. Stitch these designs to raise awareness or for fundraising, the designs include the Willow Tit, Pine Marten, Grey Long-Eared Bat, Pheasant's-eye, Interrupted Brome, Shril Carder Bee and Chequered Skipper.

### Pine Marten

Once very common, Pine Marten numbers were devastated by clearance of woodland and control by gamekeepers and landowners. They are now protected by law across the UK, though rare in England. They are faring well and spreading in Scotland and they will soon start to re-colonise parts of Northumberland and Cumbria where habitat is suitable.
