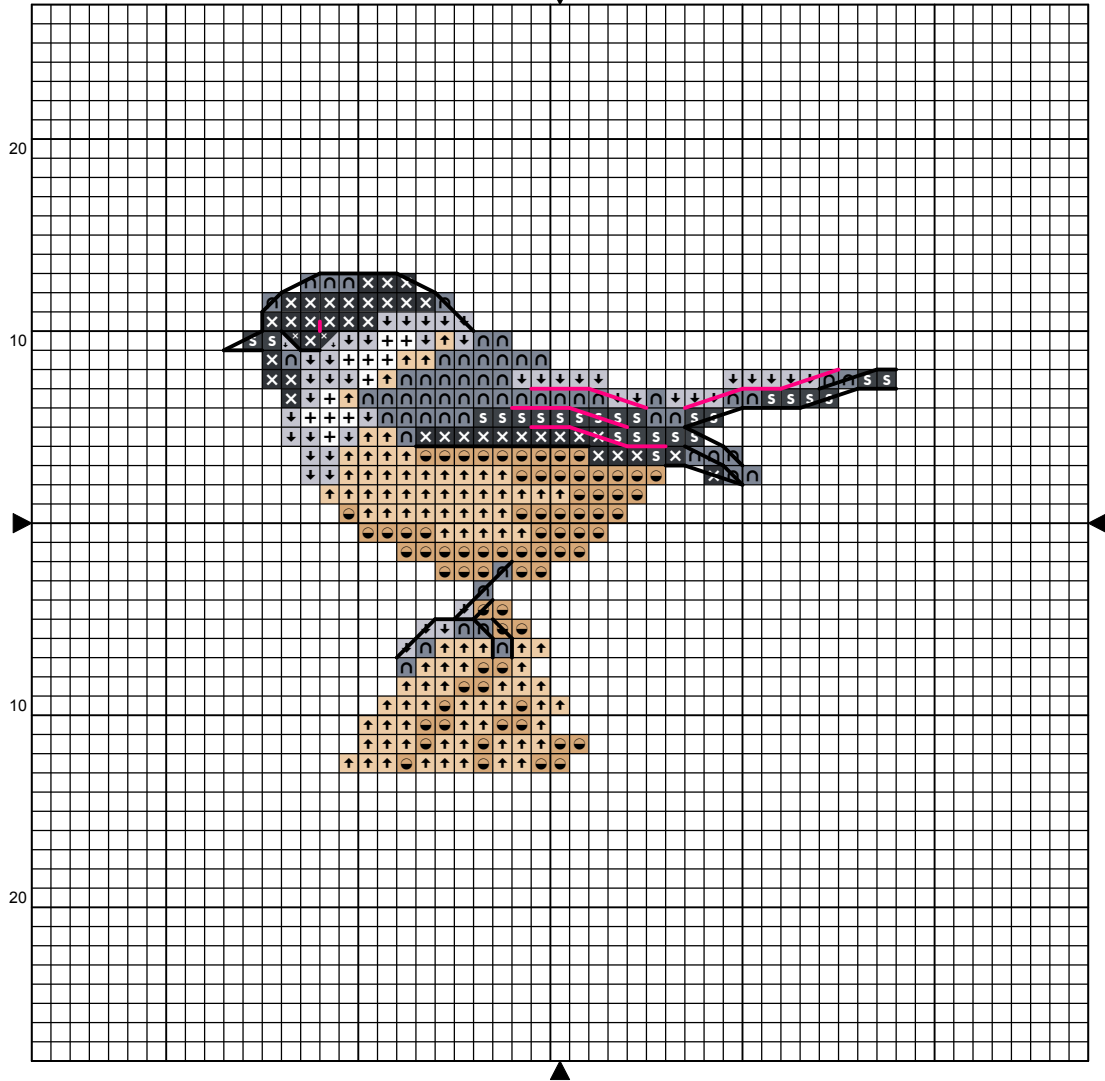

## Instructions and Symbol Key for Design "BftB Willow Tit"

**Fabric:** 14 count White Aida

**Stitches:** 35 x 26      **Size:** 2.50 x 1.86 inches or 6.35 x 4.72 cm

**Colours:** DMC

Use 2 strands of thread for cross stitch

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### Back from the Brink

A set of seven endangered British Wildlife designs created in partnership with Back from the Brink, an ambitious conservation project focussed on bringing some of Britain's most threatened species of animals, plants and fungi back from extinction. Stitch these designs to raise awareness or for fundraising, the designs include the Willow Tit, Pine Marten, Grey Long-Eared Bat, Pheasant's-eye, Interrupted Brome, Shriill Carder Bee and Chequered Skipper.

### Willow Tit

The Willow Tit found in Britain is slightly different to the Willow Tits found everywhere else in the world; we have our own special subspecies. Unfortunately the Willow Tit is our most threatened resident bird and one of our fastest declining with possibly only 3,000 pairs remaining.
